Events & Rules

Western attire required for all contestants

Branding: Team must rope and brand two head of livestock.

Rules: When first number is called team will ride into heard and rope that number (head and heel) once steer is on its side, they will then proceed to put a brand on left hip. When ropes are off and cow is on its feet the next number will be called and team will rope and brand the second steer. Time will stop when second steer has been branded and all ropes are off.

Each team has 5 minutes to complete branding.

Failure to complete in 5 minutes or less will result in a 10 minute penalty

Mugging: Team must rope and tie-down steer

Rules: When steer number is called team will head steer. Other team members will wrestle steer to the ground and tie three legs together. Time will stop when steer has been tied and hands are raised. Steer must remain tied for six seconds.

Failure to complete in three minutes or if steer does not remain tied will result in a 6 minute penalty.

Ranch Sorting: Teams will pen cattle in numerical order

Rules: When number is called team will proceed to pen cattle in numerical order, leaving two trash cattle in big pen. Teams will be disqualified if order is broken, if trash cattle enter pen, or if any cattle escape pen once they have been captured.

Teams will be penalized 10 seconds for each head of cattle they do not get penned. (Ex. Team pens four (4) head and leave six in pen they will be penalized 60 seconds. Total time for team would be 4 minutes.)

Time limit will be three minutes.

If team is disqualified they will be assessed a 6 minute penalty.
